## Serving for *Influence*

- 1. Christ is the model (Philippians 2:3-8)
- 2. Pretty tough to serve unless...
  - You love Jesus
  - · You love people
  - You have strong convictions to serve (see sidebar, "Forming Convictions.")
- 3. Why serve?
  - Jesus did (Mark 10:45)
  - He expects us to (John 13:13-17)
  - It moves hearts.
    - This is not "I scratch your back so you'll scratch mine."
    - We serve for Jesus' sake (2 Cor. 4:5), to influence people for His kingdom.
      - a. Believers--to build up (1 Thess. 5:11, 14-15)
      - b. Non-believers--to win to Christ (1 Cor. 9:19-23)
