





PRINCIPLES FOR HELPING OTHERS

(John 17)

Verse

- 3 Our job is to lead them to Christ
- 6 God *gives* to us the people in which we are to invest our lives
(also verse 9, 24)
- 7 They need to know that *everything* of worth that we have is from God Himself (also verse 10)
- 8 We need to give them *God's Word* (also verse 14, 17)
- 9 Realize that they are *not ours*, but God's – They are “on loan” from Him
- 10 Our objective is to *glorify* Christ
- 11 We are to walk in *unity* – as an example to unbelievers
(also verse 21, 22, 23)
- 12 We are to *guard* the younger one
- 15 We are to pray for their *protection* from Satan
- 16 We are *pilgrims* in this world (just passing through)
- 17 The objective is *holiness* – sanctification as we are exposed to God's Word (also verse 19)
- 18 We have been sent into the world as *ambassadors* for Jesus Christ.
- 19 We can have an *impact* on future generations *through these* which we help today
- 23 As we allow Christ to live “in us,” the world understands that Christ loves them
- 24 Our reward will be to someday be with Him and behold *His glory*
- 25 We must understand that God *sent* Christ to us because of His love for us, and in turn *sends us* to others
- 26 As we minister to others, it is done in the *strength* of His love in us, which is from God
