II. We have lost a spirit of reverence in modern worship

A. The name of God refers to God's self-sufficiency.

B. The Jews covered the name of God up in reverence.

III. We were created for a specific purpose—to worship God.

A. Man has lost the music of worship from his heart so he substitutes answers for why he is here.

B. However, his ultimate purpose is to worship God.

C. God did not save us from the things we do, but for worship.

D. Man is to be a worshipper before a worker.

E. God did not merely make a man so that he could get things from Him.
