 - E. The true Christian is glad to share Jesus Christ.
- III. One is either a real Christian or a half Christian who is going nowhere.
- IV. Jesus Christ comes into the life of the one who needs and wants him. We must ask him to come into our lives by telling Christ we are sinners—that we are prepared to turn our lives over to him and by asking him to come into our lives.
- V. Walk in Jesus after you have received him.
 - A. Jesus lives in us to help us overcome temptation.
 - B. The next step is to witness.
 - C. We cannot live the Christian life, but Jesus can live it through us.
