## I. Introduction.

- A. Text: Romans 9.
- B. The Jews believed that Messiah would come, but they rejected Jesus Christ as Messiah.
- C. Paul gives reasons why Israel's unbelief does not violate God's character.
  - 1. The unbelief of Israel is not inconsistent with God's person.
  - 2. The unbelief of Israel is not inconsistent with God's prophets.
  - 3. The unbelief of Israel is not inconsistent with God's prerequisites.
- II. The unbelief of Israel is not inconsistent with God's promise.
  - A. God cares for Israel and gave them much.
  - B. Rejection is still consistent with God's faithfulness. (Jeremiah 32:42, Isaiah 52)
  - C. Spiritual Israel is contained within ethnic Israel. There is a difference between religion and righteousness. (Hebrews 11:4, John 1:48, 8:39, Galatians 3:6-9, 29, Isaiah 9:29)
  - D. God has preserved a righteous remnant among the Jews. Not all who are from Abraham are part of the promise. (Genesis 21:13)
  - E. The one that God chose demonstrated that he was chosen and the one that God did not choose demonstrated that he was not chosen. (Genesis 18:10; 25:23, II Chronicles 25, Numbers 20:18, Amos 1, Obadiah, Malachi 1, Psalm 5, 11:5, 26:5, Proverbs 6:16, Jeremiah 34:4, Hosea 9:15, Amos 5:21, Zechariah 8:17, Malachi 2:16)
  - F. God chooses to glorify Himself.
  - G. Everyone is chosen by God before He is born as a mystery.
  - H. God calls effectually for salvation. (John 8:30, 9:27, I Corinthians 1:29, 7:15, Galatians 1:6,-15, 5:8-13, Ephesians 4:1-4, Colossians 3:15)
