II. Psalm 139.

B. God knows all about us - He even knows what we think.

2. It is a comfort because we are never alone.

3. There are sometimes that we are more aware of the presence of God - we just know that He is there.

D. We can ask God to search our hearts and try our ways that we would be right with Him.
