I. Introduction.

- A. Text: Isaiah 60:22.
- B. This text motivates for ministry.

II. A little one shall become a thousand.

- A. A little one must become a thousand because the harvest is so plentiful and the laborers are so few. (Matthew 9:37)
- B. The work of the Navigators is to multiply laborers to reach the great harvest. (John 4)
- C. A little one can become a thousand by multiplication or addition.
 - 1. Peter ministered to the harvest by preaching to many (addition).
 - 2. Andrew ministered to the harvest by bringing in one at a time (multiplication).
- D. It is necessary for a laborer to be faithful and able if he is to multiply like Andrew. (2 Timothy 2:2)
 - 1. He must be faithful.
 - 2. He must be able to teach.
 - a. Scripture memory. The Bible talks about hearing the Word in such a way to remember and do it.
 - b. Pray as you walk.
 - c. Man to man ministry.
- E. God wants to use little people like you so that He gets the glory. (Isaiah 21:40)
- F. God will make the little large.
 - 1. He resists the proud and gives grace to the humble. (James 4:6)
 - 2. God is the one who will accomplish the need. (Isaiah 57:17)
 - 3. The need of the hour is men who believe God sincerely.
