

Remember Jesus Christ

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I. Introduction.

- A. Text: 2 Timothy 2:8-13.
- B. The text can simply read “remember Jesus Christ.”
- C. Encouragement comes in these three words.

II. We are encouraged in remembering Jesus Christ.

- A. He suffered as we do and for us.
- B. He is an example for us.
- C. Jesus as the perfect Son of God who was burying the sin of those who watched Him die. (Matthew 26)
- D. Looking unto Jesus is the triumphant gaze of the soul. (Hebrews 12:2)
- E. Jesus lived amidst His enemies—He knows all about our struggles.

III. Remember Jesus risen from the dead.

- A. It was a demonstration that Jesus was the Son of God. (Romans 1:4)
- B. Jesus is God on earth—what God would do Jesus would do.
- C. We have pardon through Him.
- D. We have peace.
 - 1. As a result of this we have pardon through the one mediator. He is our peace. (Ephesians 2:14)
 - 2. Christ is also our peace with one another. Knowing that we are forgiven sinners in Jesus Christ allows for a better relationship between others.
 - 3. We have peace down inside of us.
- E. We have power.
 - 1. Since Jesus goes with us, we go anywhere.

2. We have power from Christ's resurrection. (Romans 5:10)
3. We are daily being delivered from sin's dominion.

F. We have paradise. We live because Jesus lives and as long as He does.

IV. Remember Jesus the son of David.

A. This means He is a man who is a high priest that He can identify with us. (Hebrews 5:12)

B. Jesus experiences temptation like we do.

C. We identify with Christ in the things that he did. (Hebrews 7:25)
